
microKeyer II and TrueTTY Setup

Router setup:

Note: The absolute port numbers do not matter. The key is consistency - the same port number must be used for a specific function every time it is used.


- 1. TrueTTY does not use a radio control port. You may assign the Radio port for use by a logger or OmniRig.
- 2. TrueTTY does not use the CW Port but you may assign a port for CW and PTT for use by CW Type.
- 3. Assign a port for FSK. Check the PTT and "strict BPS" boxes.



4. Save settings to a preset by selecting menu **Preset | Save as.** Choose a position and name it TrueTTY.

TrueTTY setup:

- 1. Click Setup | Interface
- 2. Set the PTT to the port you selected for FSK in Router.
- 3. Set PTT pins to RTS



- 4. If you will be using FSK for RTTY, check "Produce FSK output at TxD"
- 5. Select **microHAM CODEC** as the sound card.
- 6. Set other options as needed for your operation.
